GOD'S WORD TODAY

Today's Gospel presents us with a scene that is echoed time and time again in our society. From an early age, most of us have been encouraged to be first-first in line, first in the class, first to be picked for the team. This encouragement continues throughout our lives. Being first is fundamentally about power there is absolutely nothing wrong with being first. The problems set in when we use the power of being first to manipulate and use the people we consider somehow "beneath" us. So many problems of our world and church revolve around this kind of abuse of power. Let us pray that today's Gospel, which addresses these issues head on, will inspire all to use their power in ways that build up rather than tear down and destroy.

LA PALABRA DE DIOS HOY

Let us test him with insult and torture, so that we may find out how gentle he is, and make trial of his forbearance.
