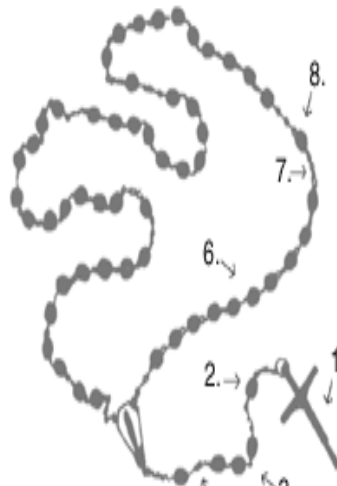

8. Repeat from 5 to 7
