

The foreshadowing of the new age

From the pastoral constitution on the Church in the modern world of the Second Vatican Council

We do not know the time when earth and humanity will reach their completion, nor do we know the way in which the universe will be transformed. The world as we see it, disfigured by sin, is passing away. But we are sure that God is preparing a new dwelling place and a new earth. In this new earth righteousness is to make its home, and happiness will satisfy, and more than satisfy, all the yearnings for peace that arise in human hearts. On that day, when death is conquered, the sons of God will be raised up in Christ; what was sown as something weak and perishable will be clothed in incorruption. Love and the fruits of love will remain, and the whole of creation, made by God for man, will be set free from the frustration that enslaves it.

We are warned indeed that a man gains nothing if he wins the whole world at the cost of himself. Yet our hope in a new earth should not weaken, but rather stimulate our concern for developing this earth, for on it there is growing up the body of a new human family, a body even now able to provide some foreshadowing of the new age. Hence, though earthly progress is to be carefully distinguished from the growth of Christ's kingdom, yet in so far as it can help toward the better ordering of human society it is of great importance to the kingdom of God.

The blessings of human dignity, brotherly communion and freedom—all the good fruits on earth of man's co-operation with nature in the Spirit of the Lord and according to his command—will be found again in the world to come, but purified of all stain, resplendent and transfigured, when Christ hands over to the Father an eternal and everlasting kingdom: “a kingdom of truth and life, a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love and peace.” On this earth the kingdom is already present in sign; when the Lord comes it will reach its completion.

La esperanza de la tierra nueva

De la Constitución pastoral *Gaudium et spes*, sobre la Iglesia en el mundo actual,
del Concilio Vaticano segundo

No conocemos ni el tiempo de la nueva tierra y de la nueva humanidad, ni el modo en que el universo se transformará. Se termina ciertamente la representación de este mundo, deformado por el pecado, pero sabemos que Dios prepara una nueva morada y una nueva tierra, en la que habita la justicia y cuya bienaventuranza llenará y sobrepasará todos los deseos de paz que brotan en el corazón del hombre. Entonces, vencida la muerte, los hijos de Dios resucitarán en Cristo, y lo que se había sembrado débil y corruptible se vestirá de incorrupción y, permaneciendo la caridad y sus frutos, toda la creación, que Dios creó por el hombre, se verá libre de la esclavitud de la vanidad. Aunque se nos advierta que de nada le vale al hombre ganar todo el mundo si se pierde a sí mismo, sin embargo, la esperanza de la tierra nueva no debe debilitar, al contrario, debe excitar la solicitud de perfeccionar esta tierra, en la que crece el cuerpo de la nueva humanidad, que ya presenta las esbozadas líneas de lo que será el siglo futuro. Por eso, aunque hay que distinguir cuidadosamente progreso temporal y crecimiento del reino de Dios, con todo, el primero, por lo que puede contribuir a una mejor ordenación de la humana sociedad, interesa mucho al bien del reino de Dios. Los bienes que proceden de la dignidad humana, de la comunión fraterna y de la libertad, bienes que son un producto de nuestra naturaleza y de nuestro trabajo, una vez que, en el Espíritu del Señor y según su mandato, los hayamos propagado en la tierra, los volveremos a encontrar limpios de toda mancha, iluminados y transfigurados, cuando Cristo devuelva a su Padre "un reino eterno y universal: el reino de la verdad y la vida, el reino de la santidad y la gracia, el reino de la justicia, el amor y la paz". En la tierra este reino está ya presente de una manera misteriosa, pero se completará con la llegada del Señor.



Summer Mission coop Appeal 2023----LOVE AND CARE MISSION

Invited by the Diocese of Brooklyn, NY- we make the summer mission coop appeal at Visitation of Blessed Virgin Mary –Parish, Brooklyn, on September 09,10 by Rev. Vijay Joseph

“Love and Care Mission” is a not-for-profit, tax exempt, catholic organization based in New York, announcing the good news of Jesus by helping the poor and needy- worldwide.

LCM was founded by priests and lay people, supported by Bishops with a vision to answer the call of God to serve the poor and the needy. The founding directors have been in such ministry for many years. Our ministry is based on Jesus’ mission of healing the sick and comforting the afflicted and to bring the good news of salvation to all. LCM is committed to Respect life, specially to alleviate the sufferings of the poorest of the poor, sick and needy children in the developing world. These children need our care and attention. We helped 8,635 children last year. The organization currently supports projects in India, Nigeria, Kenya and Ghana. We help through 7 dioceses, 9 Religious (Nuns) congregations and 4 not for profit organizations. Some of our prominent projects are:

1. HIV/AIDS CHILDREN CARE: LCM supports the HIV/AIDS children at Bangalore/ Mysore, at Tuticorin, St. Joseph leprosy hospital run by the FMM Sisters and Gramodhaya- (a not-for-profit organization). They serve hundreds of HIV/AIDS affected families and children.
2. ORPHAN CHILDREN: LCM supports 7 orphanages in 6 dioceses.
3. STREET CHILDREN: supports 98 ran away from home children in 2 street children projects.
4. TRIBAL CHILDREN: Provides education to 105 poor Tribal Children in India & Africa.
5. POOR CHILDREN EDUCATION PROGRAM: Provides school fees, school supplies, and dress to the school going poor children in 8 centers in India, Ghana and Nigeria
6. EVENING STUDY CENTERS: Provides space for students whose houses have no electricity and no space. Teachers are available to give assistance to students whose parents are uneducated. These 16 centers are highly beneficial to poor students to keep going to school.
7. Providing DRINKING WATER: to Schools and villagers who walk long distance for water, by digging bore wells and building water tanks. So far 11,760 were benefitted.
8. SEMINARIANS SUPPORT: LCM supports Vocations in the missions by helping the poor young men for their studies in the seminary.
9. LEPERS’ (Children)CARE: supports 95 families suffering Leprosy in Nigeria and in India and giving Special care for their children.
10. FOR THE AGED: Provides services such as nursing care; supplies of medicine, food, and clothing; and emotional and spiritual support in 3 centers.
11. CARING MENTALLY CHALLENGED WOMEN & CHILDREN: supports programs at St. Joseph’s Charity home, Adaikalapuram, and Chingleput projects which reach out 135 mentally challenged women and children.
