### God's Word Today

The feast of the Baptism of the Lord stands as a hinge between the Christmas season and the beginning of Ordinary Time. Just as the Israelites passed through the waters of the red Sea and became God's chosen people so, too, does the Lord Jesus pass through the waters of the Jordan River. As he emerges from the water, Jesus hears the voice of his Father, who calls him "my beloved Son." The Israelites began their sojourn in the desert following their deliverance through the sea. The Lord Jesus, after his baptism by John, begins his forty-day retreat in the desert, where he is tempted by Satan. The Israelites constantly turned their backs on God. The Lord was resolute in his determination to fulfill the plan established by his heavenly Father. What does this feast teach us? On our own journey through life we must become more and more like Christ. As the liturgical year continues to unfold, let us be resolute in our commitment to become better disciples, more and more like Christ with each passing day.

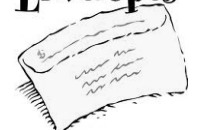
