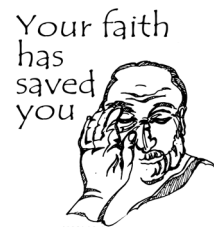

TRUE BLINDNESS

Bartimaeus caused a stir. Normally he sat by the side of the road being a "good blind beggar." But one day Jesus passed nearby. Bartimaeus jumped up and called out to Jesus. We can imagine him turning toward the direction of the commotion and noise. Bartimaeus probably had his arms outstretched as he shouted out to the son of David. The people who knew him were embarrassed by his outburst. They tried to hush him up and get him to sit back down by the roadside. Their actions spoke volumes: "Bartimaeus, you're not fit for Jesus." But it was okay for them and other "sighted" people to follow Jesus. In today's readings, we learn that true blindness is not a condition of our eyes but of our hearts.

Pero sí estaba bien que ellos y otras personas "con vista" siguieran a Jesús. En las lecturas de hoy, aprendemos que la verdadera ceguera no es una condición de los ojos sino del corazón.

On solid ground again

(Testimony of a cancer healing— **Lioba Radke**,
20 years consecrated in the Catholic community
'Koinonia John the Baptist' has lived in Jerusalem
since 2006)



This was my situation . I was not sure what lay before me. I was in the Lord's hands. On Easter Tuesday I had an appointment with a very good internist. In the light of the facts, she decided to send me for an urgent colonoscopy two days later. On the Friday of Easter week, which incidentally this year corresponded with Good Friday of the Orthodox Church, the doctor personally called me to her clinic. The diagnosis was **colorectal cancer**. I was resigned to this. That morning I had read the letter of the apostle Paul to the Philippians: " *I am caught between the two. I long to depart this life and be with Christ, for that is far better. Yet that I remain in the flesh is more necessary for your benefit.*" (Phil 1:23-25) I immediately called my community in Israel to tell them the news. I knew that they would begin to pray. Before long our Generalate sent a circular letter to all the community of Koinonia John the Baptist to inform them of my health, and so a great chain of prayer began. That same day the internist sent me to the oncology department. There, the chief oncologist was waiting for me. He very kindly explained the treatment that I had to face . It would be an operation to implant a port in the right breast, two weeks of chemotherapy and six weeks of radiation therapy. The next day he told me that throughout his career as a doctor, he had never seen a person so peaceful in such a situation: "You must have trust in God," he said. The truth was that in this new and difficult situation, the Lord began to sustain me.
